ADVANCED PHARMACY PRACTICE SURVEY RELEASED

The Advanced Pharmacy Practice Framework Steering Committee is a profession-wide collaborative forum established to progress tasks and initiatives associated with the national competency standards for pharmacists.

Late last year, an Advanced Pharmacy Practice Framework for Australia (the 'APPF') was released by the Committee on behalf of the pharmacy profession. The APPF was subsequently endorsed by the Pharmacy Board of Australia.

The Committee recently commenced work on the next stage of the advanced pharmacy practice project which will be on the implementation of the APPF. As a first step, the Committee has today released an Advanced Pharmacy Practice Survey and invites input from pharmacists who may already be practising at an advanced level or are actively working towards this goal. The survey will help inform the Committee to determine what areas or types of 'advanced' level practice Australian pharmacists are involved in.

This work will complement the Committee's other activities which include the development of a possible pathway for formal recognition of advanced pharmacy practice.

The Committee appreciates the contribution of all pharmacists to help shape the future of the profession in the area of advanced practice.
